

Home Learning Tasks – Week beginning 18th May

This week we are still thinking about how we grow and change. Adults, here are a few ideas for activities that you could try with your child:



Discuss family members with your child. Ask them who is the tallest and shortest. Discuss the different hair colours/styles in your family, repeat with family eye colours. Ask your child to talk about similarities and differences.



Discuss the jobs that everyone in your family does. Ask your children if they know what you do? Discuss what they do, ie usually go to school, and why.

Ask your child what they might like to do when they grow up.



Look at the resources for this week. There are pictures of some different occupations. Ask your child if they know what job these people do and if they would like to do any of these jobs. Ask your child to draw a picture of themselves working as an adult. If this is too tricky for them to imagine, ask them to draw you or someone they know working.

Encourage your child to watch this a few times this week until they know the story. Then ask them all about what happens to Titch and what he does.



If you have a printer, print out the Titch story cards. Help your child to cut them out and then support them with sequencing the cards in the correct order for the story. They could glue the pictures in the correct order.



Repeat the hiding game to describe **where** something is. Ask your child to choose a favourite teddy or toy & play this game with them: ask them to put the toy **on, under, on top of, next to, in front of, behind** etc a chair / table / bed. Then you hide the toy and ask the child to say where it is – who will be the winner? Make it fun to help them to learn these words.
