
What happens if my child has difficulties with learning?

This flow diagram show what happens if parents or teachers have concerns about a child's progress or learning. Parents are encouraged to talk to their child's class teacher or make an appointment to see the SENDCo directly if they have concerns about their child's learning.



Child's progress is reviewed regularly by teachers & SENDCo and discussed with parents.



Child's progress is good

Child is removed from Cause for Concern list. Progress continues to be monitored by class teachers.

Child is starting to make progress

Child remains on Cause for Concern list.

Progress continues to be monitored by teachers & SENDCo.

Child is still not making progress

SENDCo consults parents to suggest that child is included on the SEN Register.
