Friday 30<sup>th</sup> April

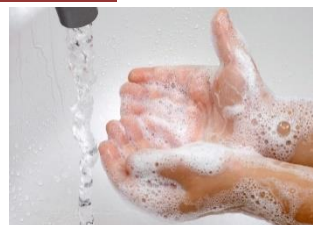
Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> May
