English

Mathematics

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We will be focusing on Place Value, addition and subtraction this term in Mathematics. We would be grateful if you could **practise and consolidate the 2, 3, 5 and 10 times tables with your child** (forwards and backwards)

Theme/Science

In the first part of the Autumn Term our theme is 'Knowing me, knowing you'. We will look at a range of different stories about friendship and how to work well with others.

During Autumn 1 in Science, we will be studying Animals including humans. Children will complete tasks on how they have grown over time; focusing on how they have changed from a baby, to a toddler, to now. We will also be learning about Animals and their babies.

During the second half of the Autumn Term we will focus on Science and our topic will be called 'Material world'. We will look closely at different everyday materials and why they have been used. Children will have the opportunity to design and create an item. They will pick suitable materials and explain why they have been used.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION	 Our PE day this term is Wednesday. PE is part of our academy curriculum and we expect all children to come to school in their PE kit so that they can take part in their indoor and outdoor PE sessions. All jewellery must be removed. Your child will also be assigned an ebook <u>or</u> given a book to bring home that matches their reading ability. We expect children to be reading for at least 10 minutes daily . It would be really beneficial if you could listen to your child read and discuss their book regularly to support their understanding. Your child is able to change their own reading book in the library, when they have read with an adult at least three times. Please record any reading you do in your child's reading diary. Their books will be changed every Thursday.	FOREST SCHOOL/ TRIPS	The children are going on an exciting trip to Beaumanor Hall on Thursday 28 th September 2023. It will be a Pirate themed day. During the second half of Autumn term we will be visiting a local Church. This term forest school will be on a Monday, please send a pair of wellies or a change of shoes that can get muddy. Children will also need a waterproof jacket. We will go out in all weathers.
